The ECSA Ambassadors Programme is being developed and will be implemented in partnership with ECSA's recognized VA's. It comes at an opportune time for both ECSA and the engineering industry, following the recent gazetting of the Identification of Engineering Work (IDoEW). As we prepare for the enforcement of IDoEW on 01 April 2025, there is a pressing need for robust industry engagement plans and activities. This programme aims to address this need by growing our fraternity through the dedication and hard work of young individuals who consistently demonstrate leadership potential.

We invite your esteemed association to nominate individuals for consideration as ECSA-VA Future Leaders Ambassadors. The selected Ambassadors will play a crucial role in promoting ECSA's mandate and facilitating industry engagements. They will serve under the programme for a period of 2 years (24 months).

To be eligible, a nominee for the ECSA Ambassadors Programme must meet the below criteria:

1. Young Engineering Practitioners below the age of 35
2. Registered with ECSA
3. Sourced primarily from VA's and/or major engineering employers
4. Diverse and Representative group: Provinces, Engineering Disciplines, Gender, Race
5. Demonstrated leadership potential and/or recognition
6. Activities carried out on a voluntary basis
7. Demonstrate a willingness to engage with and promote ECSA's mandate and mission
