NATURE OF CONTRAVENTION:

Guilty of contravention of Rule 3.1(a), 3.1(b), 3.1(c), 3.2(a), 3.2(c), 3.2(g), 3.3(a) and 3.5(a) of the Rules of Conduct for Registered Persons promulgated under Board Notice 41 of 2017, Government Gazette number 40691 of 17 March 2017.

SANCTION

- 1. The Respondent in terms of the provisions of section 32(3)(a)(i), is cautioned and reprimanded not to conduct himself in the manner he did in future.
- 2. The Respondent is liable for the amount of R 10 000 (Ten Thousand Rand) in terms of section 32(3)(a)(ii) of the Act.
- 3. The Respondent's registration is in terms of section 32(3)(a)(iii) suspended for a period of (6) six months on condition that the Respondent is not found guilty of any transgression of Rules of Code of Conduct for Registered Persons: Engineering Professions Act, 46 of 2000 during the period of suspension.
